

Minutes of the regular meeting of the Buffalo City Council, Iowa held on July 7, 2008.

Meeting called to order by Mayor John Carson at 7 pm. Present were Councilmembers Gina Guizar, Christine Carson, Mitch Greer, and Dana Jo Smith. Also present were Director of Public Works Dwain Bollman, Police Chief Gage Adams, City Engineer Leo Foley and City Clerk Bill Bowers. Councilmember Judy Hammons was excused.

Those present recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

### **Minutes**

Motion by Greer to approve the minutes of June 2 and June 24, 2008. Seconded by Carson and carried unanimously.

### **Claims**

Motion by Greer to bring the bills to Council for discussion. Seconded by Carson and carried unanimously.

Motion by Carson to approve the claims as presented.. Seconded by Greer and carried unanimously.

### **Public Input**

The council heard from residents regarding the new Iowa smoking ban and the ditch at the corner of 2<sup>nd</sup> and Dodge.

### **Department and Committee Reports**

Bollman provided a DPW update.  
Chief Adams provided a Police update.

### **Biscuits Liquor License Renewal**

Motion by Smith to approve the annual liquor license for Biscuits. Seconded by Guizar and carried unanimously.

### **West End Curb and Gutter Payment**

Motion by Carson to approve the 1<sup>st</sup> payment on the West End Curb and Gutter. Seconded by Greer and carried unanimously. Bowers was directed to place future payments with claims.

### **Sewer Infiltration**

Council discussed storm water infiltration into the sanitary sewer system with Bollman and Foley. They explained the various methods which could be used to determine exactly where the problem is. Bollman suggested that the main culprit is probably sump pumps which are being emptied into the sewer system.

Motion by Carson to authorize Foley to prepare an analysis of the problem with possible solutions. Seconded by Greer and carried unanimously.

### **Resolutions**

Motion by Carson to approve Resolution 2008-05 "A Resolution to Support the Recreation Trail". Seconded by Guizar and carried unanimously.

### **Ordinances**

Motion by Greer to approve the 1<sup>st</sup> reading of Ordinance No. 421 "An Ordinance amending Section 2.1-3.0219 (10) of the Municipal Code of the City of Buffalo relating to Taverns". Seconded by Carson and carried unanimously.

Motion by Carson to amend Ordinance 422 to include "or responsible adult of age" to both paragraphs in the ordinance. Seconded by Greer and carried unanimously.

Motion by Guizar to amend Ordinance 422 to change 21 years to 18 years. Seconded by Carson and carried unanimously.

Motion by Carson to approve the first reading of Ordinance No. 422 "An Ordinance amending Section 2.1-1.0303 of the Municipal Code of the City of Buffalo relating to Minors". Seconded by Guizar and carried unanimously.

Motion by Carson to amend Ordinance No. 423 to state that Outdoor Service Areas will be regulated by resolution. Seconded by Greer and carried unanimously.




### **Future Meetings**
