RE: Snow Removal

I would like to remind everyone who parks a vehicle on the street during winter months of City Code 2.1-2.1012, regarding snow removal of 2 or more inches of snow. This code states that when the city crews plow snow on an even numbered date, the streets will be plowed first on the side of the street with even numbered homes – those homes on the north and west sides of the street. On odd numbered dates, crews will first plow the street on the odd numbered side – those homes on the south and east sides of the street. All vehicles must be moved from the side of the street that is being plowed and not be returned to that side until the snow is plowed to the curb.

I would also like to remind everyone that City Code 8-1.0107 makes it unlawful for **anyone** to throw, push, or place or cause to be thrown, pushed or placed, any ice or snow from **private property**, **sidewalks**, or **driveways** upon City Streets.

As with any code, if not followed a ticket could be issued by the Buffalo Police Department.
