TOWN SEAL

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A TOWN SEAL AND DEFINING ITS USES.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Town of Buffalo, Iowa:

SECTION 1. The Town Seal shall be a seal circular in form, in the center of which shall be the words "Buffalo, Iowa", and around the margin the words, "Town Seal", and the same is hereby declared to be the town seal.

SECTION 2. The town seal shall be in the custody of the mayor, and shall be attached by him to all warrants drawn on the treasurer, and to all transcripts, orders, and certificates which it may be necessary or proper to authenticate.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
