

FIRE TRUCKS

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING TERRITORY TO BE SERVED BY FIRE FIGHTING APPARATUS OUTSIDE OF TOWN LIMITS OF BUFFALO, IOWA, and PROVIDING FOR CHARGES TO BE MADE FOR SAME.

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Buffalo, Iowa:

SECTION 1. Upon the payment of twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars to the Town of Buffalo, Iowa, by any person residing outside of the town limits of Buffalo, Iowa, not to exceed five (5) miles in either direction on paving or three (3) miles on all other roads leading into the town, is to receive the services of the fire fighting apparatus at any time without cost, whenever possible to make such call. The Town of Buffalo is to resume no responsibility in case of failure to make such call after making all possible efforts to do so.

SECTION 2. Any person who has not subscribed the above amount calling for service of the fire fighting apparatus is to pay the sum of fifty (\$50.00) dollars, payable within ten (10) days from date of service rendered.

SECTION 3. Penalties: If the provisions in the preceding section are not complied with, future calls for service will be ignored until such accounts are paid.

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage as provided by law.
