FIRE ALARM

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING TAMPERING WITH FIRE ALARM AND FIRE APPARATUS AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Buffalo, Iowa:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to spread a false fire alarm in any manner whatsoever, as provided in Section 2468, Code of Iowa.

SECTION 2. It shall be deemed a misdemeanor for any person to tamper with the fire apparatus of any kind owned by the town of Buffalo, Iowa.

SECTION 3. Anyone violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be subject to imprisonment not exceeding thirty (30) days or to a fine not exceeding one hundred (\$100.00) dollars. Whenever the fine and costs imposed for the violation of this ordinance are not paid, the person convicted may be committed to jail until the fine and costs are paid, not to exceed thirty (30) days.

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
