

FIRE DEPARTMENT

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT AND DEFINING
RULES FOR ITS OPERATION.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Town of Buffalo, Iowa:

SECTION 1. The town of Buffalo hereby accepts the organization known as the Volunteer Fire Department of Buffalo, Iowa, as its official volunteer fire fighting organization.

SECTION 2. Any amendment to its by-laws or constitution now in force shall first be approved by the Council Of Buffalo, Iowa, before becoming operative.

SECTION 3. Any person while an active member of the volunteer fire department shall be exempt from a poll tax as levied by the council of Buffalo, Iowa, or from labor on the streets as provided by the Code of Iowa, 1931. (Section 1656)

SECTION 4. Any other rules or regulations prescribed hereafter by resolution by the town council shall be obeyed by the Department or any of its members.

SECTION 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
