

CEMETERY ORDINANCE.

AN ORDINANCE DEFINING AND REGULATING THE POWER CONFERRED UPON THE ROSE HILL CEMETERY ASSN. OF BUFFALO IOWA ORGANIZED APRIL 9, 1903 AND PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A CEMETERY COMMITTEE.

Be it ordained by the Council of Buffalo Iowa That:

Sec. (1) One. The Mayor of the Town of Buffalo is hereby instructed to appoint a committee of Three (3) members of the Town Council to act and be known as the Cemetery Committee.

Sec. (2) Two. The duties of the said Cemetery Committee shall consist of working in conjunction with the Rose Hill Cemetery Assn. in all cases where new improvements or any remodeling of the landscape of the Rose Hill Cemetery is contemplated.

In case the Cemetery Committee and the Rose Hill Cemetery Assn. cannot agree on the proposed work the vote of the Town Council shall be the deciding voice in the matter and be considered as final.

Sec. (3) Three. All legitimate bills presented to the Rose Hill Cemetery Assn. for payment shall after being allowed by the said Rose Hill Cemetery Assn., be signed by its Pres. and Secy. and then be forwarded to the Town Clerk for final action by the Town Council after which they are to be handled the same as all Town bills. All bills for Cemetery purposes shall be paid out of the Cemetery Fund.

Sec. (4) Four. All of the funds coming into the hands of the Rose Hill Cemetery Assn. are to be paid to the Town Treasurer together with the money received by the Town Clerk from the sale of lots of said Cemetery all of which are to be put into the Cemetery Fund.

Sec. (5) Five. No person or body shall be allowed to be entered for burial upon said Cemetery without the proper permit being issued and all General Laws of the State of Iowa governing the burial of the dead are previously complied with.

Sec. (6) Six. The aforesaid Cemetery Assn. shall cause all graves to be dug to the depth of five (5) feet for a person over the age of ten (10) years and four and one-half ($4\frac{1}{2}$) feet for a person the age of ten (10) years and under.

Sec. (7) Seven. The Sexton of the Rose Hill Cemetery shall be appointed by the Rose Hill Cemetery Assn. subject to the approval of the Town Council of the Town of Buffalo. The appointment of the Sexton shall be made annually prior to May 1 of each year.

Sec. (8) Eight. The Sexton of the Rose Hill Cemetery shall, within ten (10) days after any interment made in said Cemetery report such interment to the Town Clerk, who upon the receipt of such notice shall cause to have entered in a book kept for that purpose, the name of the person together with the date, location, and lot number upon which such interment took place.

Sec. (9) Nine. All ordinances or parts of ordinances relating to the care and maintenance of the Rose Hill Cemetery passed prior to this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Sec. (10) Ten. This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
