

ORDINANCE NO. 35 *Repealed*

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE COMPENSATION OF OFFICERS AND EMPLOYES OF THE TOWN OF BUFFALO, IOWA.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Town of Buffalo, Iowa:

Section One (1). The compensation of the officers and employes provided for in this ordinance shall be paid on presentation of bills therefor and shall be acted upon by the Council the same as other claims upon the Town.

Section Two (2). The Mayor shall receive a salary of Forty (\$40.00) Dollars per year, payable quarterly, and the fees of his office as fixed by ordinance or laws, provided that the Town shall in no case be liable for any fees.

Section Three (3). The Treasurer shall receive a salary of Eighty Four (\$84.00) Dollars per year, payable quarterly.

Section Four (4). The Town Clerk, Street Commissioner, Policemen and all other officers and employes, where no salary is fixed by ordinance, shall receive such compensation as the Council shall fix by resolution.

Section Five (5). Each Councilman shall receive One (\$1.00) Dollar for each Council meeting that he attends, not to exceed Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars in any one year, and he shall receive in addition to the foregoing, for services as a member of the Board of Review, an amount not to exceed One (\$1.00) Dollar for each session of said Board of not less than three (3) hours and the compensation for services as a member of said Board of Review shall be paid out of the County Treasury on bills filed with the County Auditor.

Section Six (6). This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
