

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED " AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE AND LICENSE THE SALE OF BEER, INCLUDING THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS AND FEES, THE CONDUCT OF PLACES SELLING BEER AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION ", WHICH WAS PASSED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BUFFALO, IOWA ON JUNE 12, 1935.

Be It Ordained by the Council of the Town of Buffalo, Iowa:

Section One (1). That an Ordinance entitled " An Ordinance to regulate and license the sale of beer, including the issuance of permits and fees, the conduct of places selling beer and prescribing penalties for violation ", which was passed by the Council of the Town of Buffalo, Iowa , on June 12, 1935, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section Two (2). This Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
