AN ORDINANCE REPEALING AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE SPECIFYING REGULATIONS TO BE FOLLOWED IN CONSTRUCTION OR RECONSTRUCTION OF BUILDINGS OR ANY PART THEREOF AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION" BEING ORDINANCE NUMBER TWENTY SEVEN (27) PASSED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BUFFALO, IOWA ON MARCH 22, 1933.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BUFFALO, IOWA:

Section One (1). That an ordinance entitled "An ordinance specifying regulations to be followed in construction or reconstruction of buildings or any part thereof and prescribing penalties for violation", being ordinance number twenty seven (27) passed by the Council of the Town of Buffalo, Iowa on March 22, 1933, be and the same is, hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section Two (2). That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section Three (3). That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage as provided by law.
