

ORDINANCE NUMBER 46

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE TOWN HEALTH DEPARTMENT RELATING TO HOUSING CONDITIONS IN THE TOWN OF BUFFALO, IOWA, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION", BEING ORDINANCE NUMBER FORTY THREE PASSED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BUFFALO, IOWA ON JULY 12th., 1948.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BUFFALO, IOWA:

Section One (1). That Section seven (7) of Ordinance number forty three (43) be amended by striking out of line three (3) of said section seven (7) the following words: "at a cost of less than fifteen hundred (\$1500.00) dollars.", and by placing a period after the word dwelling in line three (3) of section seven (7) of ordinance number forty three (43).

Section Two (2). All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section Three (3). This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
