

ORDINANCE NUMBER 48

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE COMPENSATION OF OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE TOWN OF BUFFALO, IOWA,

Be it ordained by the Council of the Town of Buffalo, Iowa:

Section One (1). The compensation of the officers and employes provided for in this ordinance shall be paid on presentation of bills therefor and shall be acted upon by the Council the same as other claims upon the Town.

Section Two (2). The Mayor shall receive a salary of ONE HUNDRED (\$ 100.00) Dollars per year, payable quarterly, and the fees of his office as fixed by ordinance or laws, provided that the Town shall in no case be liable for any fees.

Section Three (3). The Town Clerk, Street Commissioner, Marshal, Special Policemen and all other officers and employes, where no salary is fixed by ordinance, shall receive such compensation as the Council shall fix by resolution.

Section Four (4). The Town Treasurer shall receive a salary of Nine ty Six (96.00) Dollars per year, payable quarterly.

Section Five (5). Each Councilman shall receive Two (\$ 2.00) for each Council meeting that they attend, not to exceed One Hundred (\$ 100.00) in any one year.

Section Six (6). All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section Seven (7). This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
