

ORDINANCE NUMBER 49

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE CONTROLLING THE OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN THE TOWN OF BUFFALO, IOWA, PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES PREVIOUSLY PASSED RELATING TO THE OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN THE TOWN OF BUFFALO, IOWA BEING ORDINANCE NUMBER FORTY ONE, PASSED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BUFFALO, IOWA ON FEBRUARY 2, 1948.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BUFFALO, IOWA:

Section One (1). That section twelve (12) of ordinance number forty one (41) be amended by adding wording as follows, said wording to be inserted following the period in line three of the above mentioned ordinance and section: " Haker, Jefferson and Dodge streets are hereby designated as "Through Streets", and all vehicles, including bicycles shall come to a full stop before entering any intersection on the aforementioned Haker, Jefferson and Dodge streets, all located within the incorporated limits of the Town of Buffalo, Scott County, Iowa.

Section Two (2). That all ordinance's or parts of ordinance's in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section Three (3). This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after it's passage and publication as provided by law.
