

ORDINANCE NUMBER 50

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SANITARY DISTRICT IN THE TOWN OF BUFFALO, SCOTT COUNTY, IOWA, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BUFFALO, IOWA:

Section One (1). The entire corporate limits of the Town of Buffalo, Scott County, Iowa, is hereby declared to be known as one complete sanitary district.

Section Two (2). Refuse and/or other materials that are or may later become offensive to the human being, said materials shall include garbage, shall be hereafter collected semi-weekly or oftener.

Section Three (3). It shall be unlawful to store garbage, refuse or other materials as referred to in section two (2) of this ordinance, anywhere except in a metal container with a tight fitting lid, container to be placed at the property line nearest the alley.

Section Four (4). All garbage refuse etc. must be free of broken glass, tin cans or any other such materials or any offal of the human body of whatever nature, failure to meet the requirements of this section will prohibit the Garbage Collector from removing the content of garbage cans from such premises.

Section Five (5). Any person, firm, partnership or corporation receiving garbage collection service shall pay for such service in the amount as set by resolution, said payment for garbage collection to be made directly to the Garbage Collector in advance.

Section Six (6). Any person, firm, partnership or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, shall upon conviction be subject to a fine of not less than Five Dollars (\$5.00) nor more than Twenty Five Dollars (\$25.00) for each such violation. If upon conviction such fine and costs are not paid, then the convicted party may be placed in jail until such fine and costs are paid, not exceeding thirty (30) days.
