

ORDINANCE NUMBER 51

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED " AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING TERRITORY TO BE SERVED BY FIRE FIGHTING APPARATUS OUTSIDE OF TOWN LIMITS OF BUFFALO, IOWA, AND PROVIDING FOR CHARGES TO BE MADE FOR SAME", BEING ORDINANCE NUMBER TWENTY FOUR PASSED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BUFFALO, IOWA ON MARCH 22, 1933.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BUFFALO, IOWA:

Section One (1). That an ordinance entitled " An ordinance establishing territory to be served by fire fighting apparatus outside of Town limits of Buffalo, Iowa, and providing for charges to be made for same", being ordinance number twenty four (24) passed by the Council of the Town of Buffalo, Iowa on March 22, 1933, be and the same is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section Two (2). That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section Three (3). That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
