

ORDINANCE NUMBER 52

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH FIRE FIGHTING EQUIPMENT AND FIREMEN OF THE TOWN OF BUFFALO, IOWA, MAY RESPOND TO CALLS FOR FIRE FIGHTING OR OTHER EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE OUTSIDE THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF SAID TOWN.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BUFFALO, IOWA:

Section One (1). That the fire fighting equipment and firemen of said Town may respond to calls for fire fighting or other emergency assistance outside the corporate limits of said Town under the terms and conditions as hereinafter set forth.

Section Two (2). That such fire fighting equipment and firemen may respond to calls at any distance which in the discretion of the Mayor, Fire Chief or Ass't. Fire Chief of said Town shall be reasonable and proper.

Section Three (3). It shall be the duty of the Mayor, Fire Chief or Ass't. Fire Chief of said Town to decide whether response will be made to a particular call outside the corporate limits of the Town of Buffalo, Iowa.

Section Four (4) That when the fire fighting equipment or firemen of the Town of Buffalo, Iowa are on calls for fire fighting or other emergency assistance outside the corporate limits of said Town, as contemplated herein, such equipment and men shall be considered within their jurisdiction and the Town shall have the same governmental immunity as when operating within its corporate limits.

Section Five (5). That for the purpose of determining the amount to be charged subscribers in given areas, there is hereby adopted what shall be known as a fire zone map of the Town of Buffalo, Iowa, which shall be and become a part of this ordinance when certified to by the Mayor and attested by the Town Clerk of said Town and which map may be changed from time to time as circumstances and the best interests of all concerned shall warrant.

Section Six (6). That the amount to be charged for such service as may be rendered by such fire fighting equipment or firemen in the various zones as hereby created shall be as follows for subscribers:  
Zone One (1) - That territory which embraces the entire corporate limits of the Town of Buffalo, Iowa, - No charge  
Zone Two (2) - That territory contiguous to the corporation line of the Town of Buffalo, Iowa as shown by said fire zone map, the charge shall be Twenty Five Dollars (\$25.00) for a period of ten (10) years or the life of the newest fire truck, whichever date comes first.  
Zone Three (3) - That territory not being any part of zone one (1) or zone two (2) as shown on the fire zone map, the charge shall be Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for a period of ten (10) years or the life of the newest fire truck, whichever date comes first. For the purpose of defining the term "newest fire truck" as herein contained, it shall be construed to mean the newest fire truck owned by the Town of Buffalo, Iowa prior to the passage of this ordinance.

Section Seven (7). That the charge for fire fighting or other emergency assistance outside the corporate limits to a non-subscriber for such services shall be the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) plus Twenty Five Dollars (\$25.00) per hour or any fraction thereof spent in rendering or attempting to render assistance in response to request for such assistance.

Section Eight (8). That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section Nine (9). That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
