

ORDINANCE NUMBER 123

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ORDINANCE KNOWN AS ORDINANCE NUMBER 122, REGULATING THE USE OF PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SEWERS AND DRAINS, PRIVATE SEWAGE DISPOSAL, THE INSTALLATION AND CONNECTION OF BUILDING SEWERS AND THE DISCHARGE OF WATERS AND WASTES INTO THE PUBLIC SEWER SYSTEM, THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A SEWER RENTAL CHARGE, AND SEWER CONNECTION CHARGE: AND PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF: IN THE TOWN OF BUFFALO, SCOTT COUNTY, IOWA.

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Buffalo, Iowa:

Article 1:

That Article 111 entitled Building Sewers and Connections, Section 3.06 of the ordinance known as Ordinance No. 122 as described above, be and the same is hereby amended by deleting from said Article 111, Section 3.06, the second paragraph thereof, which reads as follows:

"Lateral sewers from property lines, or public easements, to 1 and 2 family residences only may be four (4") inch bituminous fibre. All commercial and industrial lateral sewers shall be of cast iron, vitrified clay or concrete as previously specified in this Section. The Town Council may, upon application by the owner, consider other methods of installation of lateral sewers on private property where conditions so warrant."

and substitute in lieu thereof, the following:

"All lateral sewers or building sewers shall be of cast iron, vitrified clay or concrete as previously specified in this section. The Town Council, may, upon application by the owner, consider other methods of installation of

Article 11--Ordinance in Force:

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after  
its passage, approval, recording, and publications as provided  
by law.
