

ORDINANCE NUMBER 135

AN ORDINANCE CONTROLLING THE INHALATION OF TOXIC FUMES FOR THE PURPOSE OF INTOXICATION, AND DEFINING THE TERMS OF INHALATION AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Town of Buffalo, Iowa:

Section One. Inhalation of fumes prohibited- No person shall, for the purpose of causing a condition, Euphoria, excitement, exhilaration, stupefaction, or dulling of the senses or nervous system, intentionally smell or inhale the fumes from any model glue, gasoline, cleaning solvent, or any other substance containing hydro-carbons, or any other substance containing agents capable of releasing toxic vapors; Provided, however that this section shall not apply to the inhalation of any anesthesia given for medical or dental purposes and under the supervision or direction of a licenced practitioner of medicine or dentistry.

Section II. Definitions- As used in this Ordinance, the term "model glue" shall mean any glue or cement of the type commonly used in the building of model airplanes, boats and automobiles, containing toluene, acetone, or other solvent or chemical having the property of releasing toxic vapors. The term "gasoline" shall mean any petroleum product which gives off or otherwise releases toxic vapors. The term "cleaning solvent" shall mean any material or substance which contains hydro-carbons and has the capability of releasing toxic vapors.

Section III. Penalties- Any person other than a juvenile violating any of the provisions of the Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined an amount not exceeding \$100.00 or be imprisoned in the Scott County jail for a period not to exceed 30 days or both. Each day such violation is committed or permitted to continue shall constitute a separate offence and shall be punishable as such hereunder. Any juvenile violating any of the provisions of this

Ordinance shall be dealt with in accordance with Juvenile Court Law and procedure.

Section IV. That all ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section V. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage as provided by law.
