

ORDINANCE NUMBER 139

AN ORDINANCE DEFINING DISORDERLY CONDUCT IN THE TOWN OF BUFFALO, IOWA. AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Town of Buffalo, Iowa:

Section 1. If any person shall commit any of the following acts he shall be guilty of disorderly conduct.

Section 2. Engage in, offer or threaten to fight or quarrel, or to use blows or violence toward another, or strike, assault, of fight another person.

Section 3. Publicly, or in the hearing of others, curse, swear, or use profane language, or blasphemous, obscene, abusive, or vulgar language.

Section 5. Make or excite any disturbance on the streets, alleys, parks, levees, or other public or private property.

Section 6. Make or cause to be made any unnecessary or unduly loud noise by yelling or screaming, or by the use of firecrackers, or any other noise producing device.

Section 7. Shoot any BB Gun, Pellet gun, of sling shot, or throw any stone, rock, bottle or any other missile.

Section 8. Any Ordinance or part of Ordinances relating to any parts of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.


Section 9. This Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
