

Ordinance Number 144

Fire Department

An Ordinance Establishing a Volunteer Fire Department and Defining Rules for its Operation.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Town of Buffalo, Iowa;

Section 1: The Town of Buffalo, Iowa hereby accepts the Organization known as the Volunteer Fire Department of Buffalo, Iowa as its official fire-fighting organization.

Section 2: The Organization shall consist of no more than One Chief, Twenty Five Firemen, and no more than Twenty Five Second Alarmers, who must have been an active Fireman with the Volunteer Fire Department of the Town of Buffalo, Iowa.

Section 3: Minimum age requirements for a member of the Volunteer Fire Department shall be at least Eighteen Years of Age.

Section 4: The Council of the Town of Buffalo, Iowa shall accept the By-laws of the Volunteer Fire Department as the Official procedure of the Department. Any changes in the By-laws must be approved by the Council.

Section 5: Any person, while an active member of the Department, shall be entitled to any of the privileges established by the Code of Iowa including Workmens Compensation Insurance.

Section 6: Any regulations provided by Resolution of the Council must be adhered to by the Department.

Section 7: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 8: This Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
