

An Ordinance Prescribing Weight Limitations of Vehicles Upon
The Public Streets In The Town Of Buffalo, And Prescribing Penalties
For Violations Thereof.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Town of Buffalo, Iowa ;

Section One: It shall be unlawful for any motor vehicle to travel
upon any street , alley, or other public right of way in the Town of
Buffalo, Iowa, except Front Street, if said motor vehicle has a gross
weight exceeding seven (7) tons, including the weight of the motor
vehicle itself, and any trailer or semi-trailer attached there-to.

Section Two: Any person violating this ordinance shall be fined
in an amount not to exceed One Hundred (100.00) Dollars or imprisoned
for a period not to exceed thirty days.
