

ORDINANCE NUMBER 154

CHILDREN ON THE STREET

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING CHILDREN FROM BEING UPON THE STREETS ALLEYS, OR PUBLIC GROUNDS AT CERTIAN TIMES AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION.

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Buffal, Iowa:

Section 1: That it shall be unlawful for any child under the age of sixteen (16) years to be upon the streets, alleys, or public grounds between the hours of Ten O'Clock P.M. Central Standard Time or Ten O'Clock P.M. Daylight Savings Time, and Five O'Clock A.M. Central Standard Time or Five O'Clock Daylight Savings Time unless accompanied by parent, guardian, or employer, or upon some errand by permission or direction of such parent or guardian, or employer and then such child shall not loiter on the way or make any undue noise by shouting or yelling or otherwise disturbing the peace.

Section 2: Any child who violates any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be subject to arrest by any peace officer or by any citizen, without process. Upon such arrest, the child shall be taken and delivered into the hands of the parent or guardian or employer of such child. Upon the second or any subsequent arrest shall be taken by the officer or person making the arrest before the Mayor for hearing, and the Mayor shall decide wether or not any information shall be filed by the Marshall before the district court of the County, charging such offender with being a delinquent child.

Section 3: This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after
