

ORDINANCE NUMBER 158

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF BUFFALO, SCOTT COUNTY, IOWA TO MODIFY AND CHANGE THE RATES AND CONDITIONS OF SERVICE FOR ELECTRIC ENERGY PURCHASED IN ACCORDANCE WITH ORDINANCE NUMBER 126. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BUFFALO, IOWA;

Section 1. The Town of Buffalo in Scott County in the State of Iowa (hereinafter called the "Town") passed and approved on March 11, 1963, Ordinance Number 126 which was approved by a vote of the people at a special election on April 23, 1963, and said ordinance became effective on May 6, 1963, all as provided by said Ordinance.

Section 2. Ordinance Number 126 authorized the Town to Contract with Iowa-Illinois Gas & Electric Company(hereinafter called the "Company") for the purchase by Town of electric energy for lighting the public streets and for supplying electric power and light to the citizens of the Town and providing for the delivery and metering of said energy and for charges to be paid therefor.

Section 3. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 126 provides as follows:

Town shall pay Company each month during the term of this agreement for all electric energy furnished hereunder in accordance with Company's Rate No. 341, Primary Electric Service, Contract Riders and the Terms and Conditions are attached hereto as exhibit A and by this reference made a part hereof. It is understood that said rate may be changed or modified as mutually agreed during the time this Ordinance is in effect.

Section 4. This Ordinance authorizes the modification of the terms and conditions of electric service prescribed by Ordinance No. 158 to conform to any change or modification made by Company from time to time under authority of any governmental regulatory body having jurisdiction.

Section 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict
