

ORDINANCE NUMBER 160

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A CHARTER FOR THE CITY OF BUFFALO, IOWA EMBODYING THE EXISTING FORM OF GOVERNMENT ON APRIL 2, 1973.

Be It Enacted by the Council of the City of Buffalo, Iowa:

Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to provide for a Charter embodying the form of government existing on April 2, 1973.

Section 2. Charter. This Ordinance may be cited as the Charter of the City of Buffalo, Iowa.

Section 3. Form of Government. The form of government of the City of Buffalo, Iowa, is the Mayor-Council form of government.

Section 4. Powers and Duties. The council and mayor and other City officers have such powers and shall perform such duties as are authorized or required by state law and by the ordinances, resolutions, rules and regulations of the City of Buffalo, Iowa.

Section 5. Number and Term of Council. The council consists of five councilmen elected at large for a term of four years.

Section 6. Term of Mayor. The mayor is elected for a term of two years.

Section 7. Copies on File. The City Clerk shall keep an official copy of this charter on file with the official records of the City of Buffalo, at the City Clerks office, shall immediately file a copy with the Secretary of State of Iowa, and shall keep copies of the Charter available at the City Clerks office for public inspection.

Section 8. When Effective. This ordinance is in effect after its final passage, approval, and publication as required by law.
