

ORDINANCE NUMBER 162

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SALARIES OF ELECTED OFFICERS OF
THE CITY OF BUFFALO, IOWA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BUFFALO, IOWA:

Section 1: The salary of the Mayor of the City of Buffalo, Iowa shall be Twelve Hundred Dollars per calender year payable quarterly.

Section 2: The Mayor shall also receive compensation for one private telephone.

Section 3: The Mayor shall receive additional compensation for expenses incurred while performing duties of this office outside the Corporation limits; subject to Council approval.

Section 4: The salary of members of the Council of the City of Buffalo, Iowa shall be Ten Dollars for each regular meeting attended and Ten Dollars for each special meeting attended.

Section 5: Members of the Council shall receive reimbursements for expenses incurred while performing duties of thier office outside the Corporation limits, subject to approval of the Council.

Section 6: The salary of the Treasurer of the City of Buffalo, Iowa shall be Four Hundred Dollars per calendar year payable quarterly.

Section 7: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 8: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from January 1, 1974.

Section 9: This Ordinance shall be posted as required by law.
