

ORDINANCE NUMBER 165⁶

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING RULES REGULATING TRUCK TRAFFIC WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF BUFFALO, IOWA ON IOWA STATE HIGHWAY #22.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BUFFALO, IOWA;

Section 1. Iowa State Highway #22, within the Corporation limits of the City of Buffalo, is hereby closed to all truck traffic with a gross vehicle weight of five (5) tons with the following exemptions:

1. Trucks traveling from the East Corporation Limits may pick up or unload cargo at any point from one hundred (100) feet of the centerline of Dodge Street East to the East Corporation Limits. Weight restrictions on these vehicles are governed by State Load Limits.

2. Any truck may use Iowa State Highway #22 west of Dodge Street provided it does not exceed the 5 ton limit or it is in the process of disposing its cargo within the Corporation Limits of the City of Buffalo, Iowa.

3. Any person found guilty of violation of any of the above provisions of this Ordinance shall be fined not more than One Hundred (100.00) Dollars or more than Thirty (30) days confinement in the County Jail.

4. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

5. This Ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.

6. This Ordinance shall be repealed by the City of Buffalo, Iowa upon completion of the reconstruction of Iowa State Highway #22 by the Iowa State Highway Commission.
