

ORDINANCE NUMBER 171

ADOPTING MAXIMUM SPEEDS ON IOWA HIGHWAY 22 WITHIN THE
CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF BUFFALO, IOWA

SECTION ONE: WHEREAS; an engineering and traffic investigation has confirmed that the posted speed limits on Highway 22 in Buffalo are no longer appropriate for the existing conditions;

SECTION TWO: AND WHEREAS, upon the basis of the engineering and traffic investigation the reasonable speed limits are:

Thirty Five (35) Miles Per Hour from Sta. 143.40(WCL) to Sta. 195-00; Forty Five (45) Miles Per Hour from Sta. 195-00 to Sta. 205.00; Fifty Miles Per Hour from Sta. 205-00 to Sta. 301.20 (ECL);

SECTION THREE: THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BUFFALO, IOWA, that the above listed speed limits hereby govern the speeds on Iowa Highway 22 in the incorporated limits of the City of Buffalo, Iowa.

SECTION FOUR: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION FIVE: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after passage and publication as required by law.
