

ORDINANCE NUMBER 176

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SPEED LIMITS FOR VEHICLES TRAVELING UPON CERTIAN PUBLIC ALLEYS OF THE CITY OF BUFFALO, IOWA AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR PERSONS VIOLATING THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE.

SECTION 1. Definition: The word alley means, in the context of this ordinance any thoroughfare owned by the City of Buffalo, Iowa that is not designated a street or road by name and is maintained by the City.

SECTION 2. Whereas there is a need for control of traffic and operation of vehicles using the alleys of the City:

A. To insure maximum security for the well being of pedestrians using the alleys for personal use, and

B. To insure the free movement of traffic through the alleys of the City;

Therefore Be It Ordained By The Council Of The City Of Buffalo, Iowa, that

Section 3. The maximum speed on the following listed alleys shall be 15 Miles Per Hour.

1. The alley between Front and Second Street commencing at Washington St. and ending at Franklin St.

Section 4. That parking in any alley be prohibited except to receive or make deliveries. Such vehicles shall be limited to Five (5) Minute parking at any one time.

Section 5. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 6. The finding of any word, phrase, sentence, paragraph, or section of this Ordinance unconstitutional does not in any way affect the validity of any other part of this Ordinance.

Section 7. Any person found of violating any part of this Ordinance shall be subject to a fine not to exceed \$100.00 or 30 days imprisonment in the County Jail or both.

Section 8. This Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its adoption and published as required by law.
