

ORDINANCE NUMBER 177

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF ELECTRIC RATES FOR CUSTOMERS SERVED BY THE MUNICIPAL DISTRIBUTION AND LIGHTING SYSTEM OF THE CITY OF BUFFALO, IOWA.

WHEREAS: The rates for electric energy, established January 19, 1976, no longer provide sufficient funds for the successful operation of the Municipal Distribution and Lighting System the City Council deems it necessary to increase the energy charge to the customers of this system.

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BUFFALO, IOWA:

SECTION ONE: The rates for electric energy commencing October 1, 1977, for customers of the Municipal Distribution and Lighting System be as follows:

First 20 KWH @ 8¢ each
Next 20 KWH @ 6¢ each
All KWH over 40 @ 5¢ each
Minimum Billing @ \$2.50 per month
First 100 KWH @ \$5.80

SECTION TWO: Any Ordinance or parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION THREE: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage and publication by law.
