

ORDINANCE #186

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF WATER RATES SERVED BY THE MUNICIPAL WATER SYSTEM OF THE CITY OF BUFFALO, IOWA.

WHEREAS: The rates for Water established in 1959 no longer provide sufficient funds for the successful operation of the Municipal Water System the City Council deems it necessary to increase the water charge to the customers of the system.

THEREFORE be it ordained by the council of the City of Buffalo, Iowa:

SECTION ONE: The rates shall be as follows:


Minimum rate 3,000 gallons	\$4.00
Next 7,000 gallons at	60¢ M
Next 10,000 gallons at	55¢ M
Next 10,000 gallons at	50¢ M
Next 20,000 gallons at	45¢ M
Over 50,000 gallons at	40¢ M.

SECTION TWO: Any ordinance or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are here by repealed.

SECTION THREE: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage and publication by law.
