

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR SPEED LIMIT RESTRICTIONS ON Y_40
WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF BUFFALO, IOWA:

WHEREAS: Y-40, a county designated road, of which 1 mile more or less
is within the jurisdiction of the City of Buffalo, and extends from
state highway #22 north has been improved with permanent concrete:

AND WHEREAS: Many new homes have been built along this right of way
since it has been improved.

AND WHEREAS: A number of entrances have been added in this area, and
a number of children are present.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BUFFALO, IOWA:


SECTION 1: That the speed limit of all vehicular traffic on
Y-40 between state highway #22 and the Buffalo City Limits to
the North be set at 35 m.p.h.


SECTION 2: Any ordinance or parts of ordinances in conflict
with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

upon passage and publication as provided by law.
