

ORDINANCE # 197

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING STREETS FOR STORAGE:

A person owning any vehicle or special mobile equipment shall not leave parked on City streets or City property, without written consent from the City Clerk's office, the aforementioned for a length of time not to exceed forty eight (48) hours. When the vehicle or special mobile equipment is left parked upon a City street or City property for a continuous period of forty eight (48) hours or more, a diligent effort shall first be made to locate the owner. If the owner is found in this search, he shall be given the opportunity to remove the vehicle in due haste. If the owner cannot be found, he may be charged and collected upon a simple notice of a fine not exceeding \$5.00, payable to the City Clerk. No costs or other charges shall be assessed. One hundred percent of all fines collected by this City shall be retained by the City.

Let it be further enacted that the above Ordinance shall be known on the simple notice as "Streets For Storage."

Let it be further enacted that the above Ordinance, if not complied with, will give reason for further action by Ordinances dealing with abandonment.
