

ORDINANCE # 211

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF ELECTRIC RATES FOR CUSTOMERS SERVED BY THE MUNICIPAL DISTRIBUTION AND LIGHTING SYSTEM OF THE CITY OF BUFFALO, IOWA:

WHEREAS: The rates for electric energy established in March, 1981, no longer provide sufficient funds for the successful operation of the Municipal Distribution and Lighting System, due to a rate increase by Iowa Illinois Gas and Electric Company, the City Council deems it necessary to increase the energy charge to the customers of this system.

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BUFFALO, IOWA:


SECTION ONE: The rate for electric energy commencing on October 1, 1982, for customers of the Municipal Distribution and Lighting System be as follows:

First 40 KWH	@13¢ each
All KWH over 40	@ 6¢ each
Minimum Billing	@\$5.20 per month

SECTION TWO: Any Ordinance or part of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION THREE: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage and publication by law.
