

ORDINANCE #215


An Ordinance to amend Article 2 of Chapter 2 of Title III of the City Code of Buffalo, Iowa, regarding vaccination of dogs & cats for rabies.


Be it enacted by the City Council of the City of Buffalo, Iowa, that Article 2 of Chapter 2 of Title III of the City Code be and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

"3-2.0206 RABIES VACCINATION. Every owner of a dog or cat shall obtain a rabies vaccination for such animal, and it shall be unlawful for any person to own or have a dog or cat in his possession, six months of age or older which has not been vaccinated against rabies. Such rabies vaccination shall be injected of anti-rabies vaccine approved by the Iowa Department of Agriculture, and the frequency of revaccination necessary for approved vaccinations shall be as established by such department. The vaccine shall be administered by a licensed veterinarian and shall be given as approved by such department. The veterinarian shall issue a tag with the certificate of vaccination, and such tag shall at all times be attached to the collar of the dog or cat."
