

ORDINANCE # 244

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING FRONT STREET AS WEST FRONT STREET AND EAST FRONT STREET AND SPECIFIC ADDRESSES AS TO WHICH SIDE OF THE STREET THEY ARE ON FOR THE ENHANCED 911 EMERGENCY SYSTEM;

WHEREAS: The enhanced 911 emergency system requires that each residence and business in the City of Buffalo have a street name and street address;

AND WHEREAS: Certain areas of Front Street are not numbered at the present time.

AND WHEREAS: Certain addresses are mixed together as to odd and even numbers on the same sides of streets.

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BUFFALO, IOWA:

That Front Street shall be known as East Front Street from the City limits on the East side of Buffalo to Dodge Street, beginning at Dodge Street and numbering upward to the East beginning in the 100 block. Front Street from Dodge to the West City limits shall be known as West Front Street, numbering upward from Dodge, beginning in the 200 block. All properties shall have a street number along Front Street.

All City streets shall have numbered addresses as follows: All addresses on the North sides and West sides shall be even numbered addresses and all addresses on the South sides and East sides shall be odd numbered addresses. Any addresses that do not now comply with this shall be sent a letter telling them that they will be issued a new street address.

Any ordinance or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
