

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING WHAT IS CURRENTLY KNOWN AS COUNTY ROAD Y-40 IN THE BUFFALO CITY LIMITS TO BE FURTHER KNOWN AS 40TH AVENUE:

WHEREAS: The enhanced 911 emergency system requires that each residence and business in the City of Buffalo, Ia., have a street name and street address.

AND WHEREAS: Certain homes or businesses have a rural route number and/or a box number as their address.

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BUFFALO, IA., CITY COUNCIL:

That County Road Y-40 in the Buffalo City Limits be hereby renamed to 40TH AVENUE, beginning at Iowa Highway #22, otherwise to be known as West Front Street, and going north, beginning with the 100 block, and any addresses on the East side shall be odd numbered and any addresses on the West side shall be even numbered. All residents or businesses not now complying shall be sent a letter notifying them of these address changes and they must change their addresses to match the address given them.

Any ordinance or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
