

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF BUFFALO, IOWA, 1988, BY ADDING A SECTION PROHIBITING UNREASONABLE ACCELERATION IN THE CITY:

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Buffalo, Iowa:

SECTION 1: NEW SECTION. The Code of Ordinances of the City of Buffalo, Iowa, 1988, is amended by adding a new Section in Chapter 2, numbered 2.1-2.0301(17), entitled UNREASONABLE ACCELERATION, which is hereby adopted to read as follows:

UNREASONABLE ACCELERATION. No person shall operate any vehicle within the City in such a manner as to create or cause unnecessary engine noise, tire squealing, skid or slide upon acceleration; or to accelerate in such a manner to cause the front tire to come off the ground; or in such manner as to simulate a temporary race or to cause such vehicle to unnecessarily sway or turn abruptly, or to impede traffic.

SECTION 2. REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 4. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
