

ORDINANCE #257

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE SPEED LIMIT WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS ON 110TH AVENUE (OTHERWISE KNOWN AS Y-48 OR LANDFILL ROAD) FROM 35 M.P.H. TO 45 M.P.H.

WHEREAS: The Buffalo City Council has decided the 35 m.p.h. speed limit on 110th Avenue (Y-48 or landfill road) is not satisfactory any longer.

AND WHEREAS: Council believes a higher speed limit would be more satisfactory when using the street.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BUFFALO, IA. CITY COUNCIL:

The speed limit on 110th Avenue (a/k/a Y-48 or landfill road) shall be 45 m.p.h. effective immediately upon passage and publication as provided by law. This is the area only within the City limits of Buffalo.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
