

AN ORDINANCE RESTRICTING PARKING ON MAPLE STREET FROM WEST FRONT STREET TO CHESTNUT STREET:

WHEREAS: The Buffalo City Council has become aware that vehicles parking on the sides of Maple Street have created a hazard for motorists approaching the area and created a parking problem for local businesses.

AND WHEREAS: The Buffalo City Council wishes to avoid any possible hazard areas.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BUFFALO, IA. CITY COUNCIL:

Parking on the East side and West side of Maple Street from West Front Street to Chestnut Street shall be limited to a thirty (30) minute parking limit and no parking shall be allowed on either side from the Stop sign North for thirty (30) feet. This is to reduce the parking problem for the local businesses in that block and to reduce congestion in the area.

All ordinances or ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
