

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE UNIFORM FIRE CODE AS THE OFFICIAL CODE OF THE CITY OF BUFFALO, IOWA:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BUFFALO, IOWA, THAT THE FOLLOWING ORDINANCE BE ADOPTED AND BECOME A PART OF THE CITY CODE OF BUFFALO, IOWA:

SECTION 1. The Uniform Fire Code in its entirety, except appendages, shall prevail as the official code governing all aspects of the building field in the City of Buffalo, Iowa.

SECTION 2. The City hereby adopts the Uniform Fire Code as prevailing at this time. As new editions become published they shall automatically become effective and prevail as the Official Fire Code of the City of Buffalo, Iowa. To the extent this section conflicts with any section of the Iowa Code, the latter section will prevail.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance be hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall become effective upon publication as required by law.
