

ORDINANCE # 269

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING YARD WASTE:

WHEREAS: The Scott County Landfill requires that grass clippings be in separate degradable bags and not mixed in with any other refuse.

AND WHEREAS: The State of Iowa does not yet have a deadline set for separation of grass clippings from the rest of the garbage.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BUFFALO, IA. CITY COUNCIL:

The City of Buffalo will require that grass clippings be put in separate degradable bags either purchased from the City Hall or their designee when the state sets the deadline for this.

This ordinance shall become effective upon passage and publication by law.

Any ordinance or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
