

ORDINANCE # 273

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF SKATEBOARDS UPON SIDEWALKS, PUBLIC STREETS, ALLEYS, PARKING LOTS OR CITY OWNED AREAS:

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BUFFALO, IOWA:

SKATEBOARDS:

Prohibited Use of Skateboards: It shall be unlawful to ride, operate, or use a skateboard upon the sidewalks, public streets, alleys, parking lots or city owned areas.

Skateboards may be used only on private property with the owner's permission obtained before using the property.

Violation - Penalty: Any person violating the provisions of this chapter shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by imprisonment not to exceed 30 days, or by a fine of not to exceed \$100.00.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed as of the date upon which this ordinance becomes effective.

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase hereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

This ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption and publication as provided by law.
