

ORDINANCE NO. 275

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE THREE, CHAPTER FOUR, ARTICLE TWO
OF THE CITY CODE OF BUFFALO, IOWA REGARDING
THE LOADING OF VEHICLES OR CONTAINERS USED FOR THE
COLLECTION AND TRANSPORTATION OF SOLID WASTE

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of
Buffalo, Iowa:

Section 1: Section 3-4.0204 of the Buffalo City Code is
hereby amended to read as follows:

LOADING. Vehicles or containers used for the collection
and transportation of any solid waste shall be loaded and moved
in such a manner that the contents will not fall, leak, or spill
therefrom, and shall be covered to prevent blowing or loss of
material. Where spillage does occur, the material shall be
picked up immediately by the collector or transporter and
returned to the vehicle or container and the area properly
cleaned. Any violation of the loading and moving, spillage
retrieval and/or cleaning requirements imposed by this ordinance
shall be unlawful, and the penalty for any violation of each
separate requirement shall be a scheduled fine of \$25.

Section 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in
conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3: If any section, subsection, sentence,
clause, or phrase of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or
unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity
of the ordinance as a whole or any section, subsection,
sentence, clause, or phrase hereof not adjudged invalid or
unconstitutional.

Section 4: This ordinance shall become effective
publication as required by law.
