

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING STOP SIGNS ON SECOND STREET FACING EAST AND WEST:

WHEREAS: A traffic hazard exists at the intersection of 2nd & Main Streets where a yield sign exists.

AND WHEREAS: Most people do not see or obey the yield signs facing east and west and is the only intersection in the business district that does not have a stop sign.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BUFFALO CITY COUNCIL:

Stop signs shall be placed facing east and west on Second Street at the intersection of Main Street.

Any ordinance or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
