

ORDINANCE # 302

AN ORDINANCE CALLING FOR A STOP SIGN AT 4TH STREET & JEFFERSON STREETS:

WHEREAS: A hazard exists at the intersection of Jefferson and Fourth (4th) Streets.

AND WHEREAS: Stop signs are in place and enforced facing East and West at this intersection.

AND WHEREAS: A hazard exists with the increase in the number of vehicles using the Jefferson Street entrance into the City from the North and exiting the City from the South going North, and the speed of these vehicles on the hill.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BUFFALO, IA:

A Stop sign will be placed at this intersection facing North and South on Jefferson Street at Fourth (4th) Street. During the winter months, the Stop sign facing North will be covered (or removed) to allow traffic better traction getting up the hill during inclement weather. The Stop sign facing South on Jefferson Street at Fourth (4th) Street will not be covered (or removed), and will be enforced.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, subsection, sentence or clause or phrase hereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

This ordinance shall become effective upon publication as required by law.
