

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 111, CHAPTER 5, CEMETERY, OF THE CITY CODE OF BUFFALO, IA:

WHEREAS: No restriction can be found in the City Code book containing glass flower containers and the planting of flowers, shrubs, trees, etc. on the graves in Rose Hill Cemetery, (Buffalo Municipal Cemetery).

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BUFFALO, IA:


No glass of any type, whether it be vases, jars, bottles, etc., will be allowed on or near the graves. No planting of flowers, shrubs, trees, etc. will be allowed to be planted on or near the graves. No type of fence or border material will be allowed to be placed on or near the graves. All decorative flowers or decorations should be placed as close as possible near or on the headstones to allow more accessibility to keep the grass mowed and trimmed in a timely manner. All violations will be removed from the graves.

Any ordinance or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.


This ordinance shall become effective upon passage and publication by law.
