

ORDINANCE # 304

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING THE AREA TO BE KNOWN AS "BUFFALO VETERANS MEMORIAL PARK"

WHEREAS: The riverfront area between Franklin Street and Main Street is an area owned by the City of Buffalo without an official identification.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BUFFALO, IA:

The riverfront area between Franklin Street and Main Street shall be known as "THE BUFFALO VETERANS MEMORIAL PARK". This area encompasses the area frequently called "the flagpole area" and "the boat dock area."


The rules and regulations for "BUFFALO VETERANS MEMORIAL PARK" shall remain the same as the PARK RULES AND REGULATIONS, 5-1.0201 in the Buffalo City Code.


Any ordinance or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective upon passage and publication by law.
