

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE TWO, DIVISION 1, CHAPTER TWO, ARTICLE 1012, OF THE CITY CODE OF BUFFALO, IOWA, REGARDING "WHEN SNOWFALL OCCURS":

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BUFFALO, IOWA:

Section 1: Section 2.1-2.1012 is hereby amended to read as follows:


1. On even-numbered calendar days, (example Dec. 04), snow plowing will be done on the even numbered addressed sides of the street. (Example is 402-3rd St.) Hereby designated even numbered sides of the streets are the North sides and the West sides of all streets.
2. On odd-numbered calendar days, (example Dec. 05), snow plowing will be done on the odd numbered addressed sides of the street. (Example is 409-3rd St.) Hereby designated odd numbered sides of the streets are the South sides and the East sides of all streets.
3. These rules are in effect when a snowfall of two (2) or more inches occurs.
4. All vehicles must be moved from the side of the street that is being plowed and not be returned to that side until the snow is plowed to the curb.
5. Any vehicles not being moved may be towed by the City at the owners expense.

Section 2: Upon effective date of this ordinance, all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.


Section 3: This ordinance shall be in full force after its final passage and publication as required by law.
