

ORDINANCE # 324

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY CODE 2.1-4.05 "COMPENSATION"

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BUFFALO, IA, THAT SECTION 2.1-4.05 "COMPENSATION" SHALL BE AMENDED AS FOLLOWS: THE POLICE CHIEF AND ANY POLICE OFFICERS SHALL BE DESIGNATED BY RANK AND RECEIVE SUCH COMPENSATION AS SHALL BE DETERMINED BY RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL. THE POLICE CHIEF SHALL BE ALLOWED TO BELONG TO THE POLICE UNION. ACCORDING TO THE UNION CONTRACT AT ANY CURRENT TIME, HE SHALL BE ALLOWED THE SAME BENEFITS AS THE OTHER POLICE OFFICERS, SUCH AS INSURANCE, HOLIDAYS, VACATION, SICK LEAVE, BEREAVEMENT LEAVE, ETC. OVERTIME PROCEDURE SHALL BE THE SAME AS LISTED IN THE UNION CONTRACT.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase hereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

This ordinance shall become effective upon publication as required by law.
