

ORDINANCE # 347

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE VI, CHAPTER VII, ARTICLE III CONCERNING BARRIERS FOR SWIMMING POOLS:

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF BUFFALO, IOWA, THAT TITLE VI, CHAPTER VII SHALL BE AMENDED BY ADDING THE FOLLOWING SUBPARAGRAPH "13" TO SECTION 6-7.0315 AS FOLLOWS:

13. BARRIERS FOR SWIMMING POOLS, SPAS AND HOT TUBS. AN OUTDOOR OR INDOOR SWIMMING POOL SHALL BE PROVIDED WITH A BARRIER THAT SHALL COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENTS AS SET OUT IN THE 1997 UNIFORM BUILDING CODE, APPENDIX, CHAPTER 4, DIVISION I THEREOF IN ALL RESPECTS. FOR PURPOSES OF THIS ORDINANCE A SWIMMING POOL IS DEFINED AS ANY STRUCTURE INTENDED FOR SWIMMING OR RECREATIONAL BATHING THAT CONTAINS WATER OVER 24 INCHES (610MM) DEEP; THIS INCLUDES IN-GROUND, ABOVE GROUND AND ON-GROUND SWIMMING POOLS, HOT TUBS, PORTABLE AND NON-PORTABLE SPAS, AND FIXED-IN-PLACE WADING POOLS.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not effect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase hereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

This ordinance shall become effective upon publication as required by law.
